So having one bean is like the ultimate symbol of poverty, you're so poor you've just got one bean. And someone who only has one measly bean to their name, who can still say, "Hey, you're hungry, I'm hungry. Let's split this bean in half so we can share," that is a generous person.

That person has enough faith in themselves, and in the universe, to know that they're going to be okay even if they give away half of what meager possession they have. That person has such a power of vision, that they can see that everything they give is returned to them eventually, in both

visible and mysterious ways. Now, that is power. That is generosity. These two go together, power and generosity.
